Important Information and Guidelines

To submit a proposal, complete the below form and submit it as a 'Special Sessions Proposal' via the conference platform, <https://radar2023-c10000.eorganiser.com.au/>, before **Wednesday, 1 March 2023, 11:59pm AEDT**. Prior to submissions, make sure you have invited and received confirmation from your speakers. Notification of acceptance is within 3 weeks, and if accepted, your speakers will be required to submit a paper by the conference deadline – **Monday, 1 May 2023, 11:59pm AEST**. All papers will undergo the review process. For papers not accepted, speakers will still have the option of submitting their work as a regular paper.

As part of the proposal, please abide by the following guidelines:

- No more than ONE paper per organiser
- Speakers must be available to attend the conference in person and understand that a conference registration for each presenter is required to remain in the program
- Must include contributors from various organisations/affiliations
- One paper timeslot may be converted to a panel discussion (optional)
- Special sessions with contributors from multiple nations are preferred
